A brief outline about the College:

Bordoloni Central College Affiliated to Dibrugarh University, 2(f) & 12(b) by UGC was set up in 1997 at Bordoloni under Dhemaji district of Assam with view to impart higher education to the poor and needy people of locality along with rest. The college now imparts education at degree level in arts stream having major courses in 13 subjects including Assamese, Anthropology, Bodo, English, Economics, Education, History, Geography, Hindi, Mathematics, Philosophy, Pol. Science

and Sociology along with career oriented courses in Computer Application, Yoga Education and Production of Water Hyacinth Accessories. Besides, the college has been imparting HS Course (Arts & Science) in a separate mode. Distance education courses (MA, BA) have been running in Assamese, English, Political Sc., Economics, Education, Mathematics and Sociology under Dibrugarh University. The college organized more than 10 National Seminar cum Workshops sponsored by UGC; ICSSR etc. on Burning Issues.

THE THEME

North - East India is one of the most socio- economically backward regions in India till now. Rural cum urban unemployment problem is a burning issue in North East India. In the same time the **Covid -19 Pandemic** imposed another immense negative impact on the socio- economy condition of the agricultural based North East states of India.

Due to lockdown announcement by government, many thousands of labours were dismissed from their jobs cum engagement. Thousand of labours were lost engagement and returned to their home states from the various metropolitan cities like Delhi, Mumbai, Madras, Hyderabad etc. of India.
